



TOURNAMENT HOST COVID-19 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Although there is a decline in the rate of new COVID-19 cases in Illinois, it is still a major issue. This disease is potentially life-altering or deadly, particularly in those with risk factors. Social distancing should NOT be taken lightly, and all aspects of the game environment must be assessed and modified to identify and reduce the risk of spreading the virus.

In order to host an Illinois Youth Soccer (IYSA) approved Tournament in Illinois during Restore Illinois Phase 4 of the COVID-19 crisis, the Tournament Host must abide by the following COVID-19 requirements, [the Illinois Youth Soccer Protocol for Phase 4](#), the Restore Illinois Youth Sports Reopening [Guidelines](#) for Phase 4, and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines.

1. Each Tournament Host "Host" must submit to the IYSA the signed "[IYSA Organization Communicable Disease Agreement](#)" with the IYSA Tournament Application. Approval will be withdrawn if this Agreement is not on file with the IYSA prior to the start of the Tournament.
2. The Host must have a signed "[IYSA Communicable Disease Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Agreement](#)" on file prior to the start of the Tournament/Friendly Game from the following individuals and make them available to the IYSA upon request:
 - a. All Non-IYSA Team Participants including but not limited to the players, coaches, trainers, volunteers, associated personnel
 - b. All Tournament Host Personnel including but not limited to the Tournament directors, administrators, **referees**, **assignors**, staff, volunteers, medical staff, vendors and field marshals
3. The Host must also have the signed "IYSA Organization Communicable Disease Agreement" on file for each participating team prior to the start of the Tournament/Friendly Game and submit it to the IYSA with the IYSA Post Tournament Report.

The IYSA does not provide any insurance coverage for Covid-19 related claims. Failure to follow the state and local government public health orders, CDC guidelines and IYSA protocol including these requirements involving COVID-19 or any other communicable disease may void medical and liability coverage for your organization under the IYSA insurance placements.

Your organization is expected to strictly comply with the state, local and CDC guidelines for the resumption of play and seek advice from medical professionals and/or public health officials in your area if you have specific questions.
