

If players have a school related conflict for the Illinois Youth Soccer State Cup or Presidents Cup matches on May 15-17, May 22-24 (including the quarterfinals, semis and finals) or May 29-30 (state cup finals) TEAMS MUST INFORM chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org NO LATER THAN APRIL 6.

It is the coach / club responsibility to notify their players of all possible dates' matches could be played on.

To be considered as a conflict ALL of the following information is required to be sent to chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org no later than April 6:

1. Names of players that have conflict
2. School they attend
3. School's phone number
4. Event time and date

School events that may qualify as a conflict:

- Student (player) graduation

Events that do not qualify (please note events that do not qualify are not limited to this list):

- School Dances (Homecoming, Prom, etc...),
- School / Family Trips
- School Athletic Events i.e. conflicts with other sporting competitions
- Graduation parties

Players planning on taking the SAT /ACT Test should look at the available dates for those standardized tests and plan ahead as there are multiple dates to take those exams.

For a schedule to be adjusted for SCHOOL conflicts, teams must submit the above listed info no later than April 6.
